- 9:45-10:15 am - Directors' meeting (in Mescolare room); chaperones need to be notified prior to the event that you will be attending this meeting, and that they will be in charge of the students during that time.
- 10:15-10:40 – Directors' Choir rehearsal in the Mescolare room

- 10:45-11:55 am - Triplo in Bellco, Cambiato and Mescolare in rehearsal space. Instrumentalists will attend this rehearsal.
- 12:00- 2:00 pm –LUNCH (This time has been extended this year from previous years)
- 2:00 -2:30 pm – Concert – Directors’ Choir – Bellco Theatre
- 2:30-4:45 - Dress rehearsal/logistics run through in performance space. Choirs may not have time to sing the entirety of their repertoire.
