CODE OF CONDUCT:

- I will sing all literature designated by the choir assignment. All music will be learned in advance, **and** memorized.
- I will attend all scheduled rehearsals on March 10th and 11th, 2022, and the final concert on March 11th, 2022. No exceptions will be made to the schedule. I will attend all festival-related events.
- I am a seventh or eighth grade student eligible to participate including being a current member in good standing of my school music ensemble, if my school has a music ensemble.
- I will be on time to all rehearsals.
- I will wear a cloth or disposable mask that covers my mouth and nose for the duration of the CMASC 2022 event (all rehearsals, in the hallways, during the performance, etc.).
- **I will be focused in rehearsals, work hard, not be disruptive, and be respectful of my director, other adults, and my fellow choir members. I will adhere to the 10:00 PM curfew.**
- The possession or use of tobacco, alcoholic beverages, or illegal controlled substances by participants will not be tolerated. I understand I will be sent home if I choose to participate in these.
- Cell phones, text messaging, tablet computers like iPads and other electronic devices are not allowed in rehearsals or performances. I understand that these devices may be confiscated.
- In order to promote a professional atmosphere, I will not wear a hat, chew gum, and will dress according to my school's dress code.
- I will abide by the code of conduct for the hotel I am staying at in Denver, if applicable.
- I give permission and release of photographs or videos of my child taken during this event, to be posted on our All State website or at the school. (If you do NOT give permission, please contact your student's director.)
- I agree to support and abide by the Code of Conduct. I understand that violation of these rules will result in disciplinary action including being sent home.

ADMINISTRATIVE AND DIRECTOR'S RELEASE:
